

Consent to Personal Data Processing

1. In the sense of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter the “Regulation”), Lexum a.s., with its registered office at Antala Staška 1670/80, 140 00 Prague 4 – Krč, Id. No.: 283 98 238, registered in the Commercial Register kept by the Municipal Court in Prague, Section B, File 14318 and Cornea Lexum s.r.o., with its registered office at Antala Staška 1670/80, Krč, 140 00 Praha 4, Id. No.: 261 48 552, registered in the Commercial Register kept by the Municipal Court in Prague, Section C, File 74543 (hereinafter the “Controller”) processes the following personal data:

- name
- surname
- e-mail address
- telephone number
- examination type
- health problems described by you

Name, surname, e-mail address, telephone number, examination type, and described health problems is in compliance with Art. 6 (1)(b) of the Regulation – the processing is necessary in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract. Processing of this personal data is necessary for communication between you and the company.

2. Personal data concerning the health problems you describe constitutes a special category of personal data. Such data must be processed too in order for us to be able to offer appropriate services to you. However, your explicit CONSENT to such processing is necessary, granted to us by ticking the “consent to processing of special category of personal data”. Such processing is in compliance with Art. 9 (2)(a) of the Regulation.

3. Any and all personal data will be processed by Lexum a.s. and Cornea Lexum s.r.o. for 1 month, and, if you and the company do not conclude a contract, the data will be then erased by the company. The period is necessary for communication and arranging for the erasure of the personal data from the web database by the web hosting provider.

4. The Controller represents that any and all personal data are confidential and will not be provided to any third party. The following possible data processors constitute an exception:

- the provider of the software, Apollo Data, s.r.o., with its registered office at Štěrboholská 1434/102, 110 00 Prague 10 Strašnice, Id. No.: 246 64 791;
- INNVISSTRA CZ s.r.o. agency, with its registered office at Klášterní 5, 326 00 Plzeň, Id. No.: 263 75 885;
- and other providers of processing software, services and applications whose services are not currently used by the Controller.

5. You can withdraw your consent to processing special categories of personal data (sensitive data) any time and in any manner. The withdrawal will result in erasure of your personal data from the company's database.

6. Please note that pursuant to the Regulation, you have the right to:
 - request information on which of your personal data we process;
 - request from us access to and updating or rectification of personal data or request restriction of processing;
 - request from us erasure of such personal data; we will erase the personal data unless we are obliged or entitled to further process this data in accordance with applicable legal regulations;
 - data portability, and the right to request a copy of the processed personal data;
 - in case of processing performed on the basis of a legitimate interest of the Controller pursuant to Art. 6 (1)(f) of the Regulation, you have the right to object to the processing;
 - lodge a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection and the right to effective legal protection; if you believe that your rights under the Regulation have been violated as a result of processing of your personal data at variance with the Regulation.
